Instructions for Local Union Resolutions and Member Signatures

- 1. Have the resolution read and adopted at your next Local Union meeting.
- 2. On the resolution itself, fill in your Local Union number, date, month, and sign off as the Local.

Example:

THIS RESOLUTION WAS PASSED BY USW LOCAL <u>999</u> ON THE <u>4th?</u> DAY OF <u>March</u>, 2023

SIGNED: USW Local 999

- **3.** Have your Local Union officers sign the signature page.
- **4.** Distribute the signature page around your worksite to have your members sign on. (Please make additional copies so every member can participate.)
- 5. Please mail the finished resolution and signature page to your District Rapid Response Coordinator so they can coordinate delivery to members of Congress. *Make sure to include your name and contact information*.
