For the past several months Grosvenor Hotel workers, members of Unite Here Local 2, have been negotiating with the Hotel for fair wage increases, improved access to health care and retirement security. Thus far the Hotel has taken a hard line and refuses to address workers concerns.

Grosvenor hotel workers have not had a contractual wage increase since 2017 and as a result most service employees at the hotel are now earning minimum wage. Long term, this will have a predictable impact on service quality and customer experience.

The hotel has also refused to provide any additional funding for healthcare or retirement security. Far too many workers at the Grosvenor lack access to healthcare because they do not work sufficient hours. Moreover, employer healthcare premiums have been frozen since 2018; despite significant increases in healthcare costs since then. In the aftermath of the pandemic it is critical to increase health care funding to ensure expanded access to healthcare.

Grosvenor workers put their lives at risk to keep the hotel running and open throughout the pandemic. They showed up to work every day, putting themselves and their families at risk, because they believed, when the time came, the Hotel would do the right thing. Grosvenor workers deserve a fair contract; they deserve to be fairly compensated and they deserve to have access to healthcare.
